
JUNE NEWSLETTER





COURT UPGRADE

The committee has had lots of discussion and done a lot of investigation into "UPGRADING" our courts. They are over 10 years old and as such are beyond the warranty period. The committee has been taking advice from other clubs as well as court providers/installers.

We are currently getting quotes, some of which are as high as \$100,000. If we go ahead we anticipate that it would be done in January/February when there is not as much demand for the courts but it will depend on the availability of the court installer

INCREASE IN SENIOR MEMBERSHIP FEES
