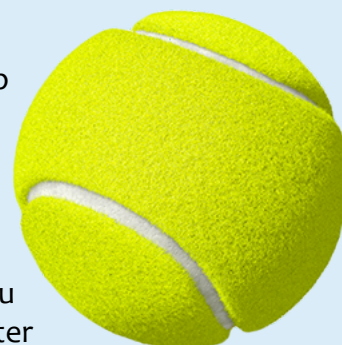
If you lose your fob, there is a \$25 charge to replace it. If this happens, please email apltconline@gmail.com
