Even if it's just a quick hit up

Don't forget to bag the court

It's not just a courtesy to the next players: bagging spreads any build up of sand evenly across the court and reduces wear and tear to the baseline.

Please remember to bag the entire court including the area behind the baselines. This not only keeps the court clean for the next players, it ensures the sand stays even across the surface.—You may need to use both the heavy and light mats to move the sand and leaves.
